Fiction & Reality in Panoramas

The 25th International Panorama Conference will focus on the theme *Fiction and Reality in Panoramas*, with illustrated presentations by select experts on this topic. The theme encompasses a discussion of what is and what is not present on the canvas and how these images reflect the past, present, or future. Attendees of the conference will visit the Feszty Panorama and pay tribute to IPC co-founding member Ottó Trogmayer (Budapest, July 24, 1934 – Szeged, 28 May 2015). Trogmayer initiated the first meetings of the IPC and, as the director of Móra Ferenc Museum in Szeged, he contributed in particular to secure the future of the Feszty-Panorama in Ópusztaszer, Hungary.
