RESOLUTION

The Panorama Conference in Szeged has shown that the problems and concerns of the different Panoramas are nearly the same. It can also be foreseen that there is an increasing necessity for the exchange of information concerning especially the scientific research of Panoramas, their conservation, their financing and their marketing (public relations).

Taking these matters into consideration the participants of the Panorama Conference of Szeged decide to found a Common Interest Group. It is to fulfil the requirements of information exchange in the following areas:

- scientific research of the Panoramas
- technology and know-how in restoration
- financing and operation of the Panoramas
- marketing and public relations

The Panorama Interest Group should organize meetings and seminars periodically. These meetings and seminars will be presided by the host country. The host country will also take care of the organization and administration of the expected activities during that year. The host country for this year, Hungary, under the presidency of Dr. Otto Trogmayer will be in charge of the following activities:

- Setting up a list of the addresses of all the Panoramas and their representatives
- Publishing the papers presented at the Szeged Conference

The representatives of each Panorama, once in position of the address list, should send the documentations of their Panorama to the others until the end of this year.

For the forthcoming year there is the option that Switzerland, under the presidency of the representative of the Bourbaki Panorama of Lucerne will take over the organization for 1993. The fact that in 1994 the Szeged Panorama will be opened, means, that the host country could be Hungary.
